GOLETA PUBLIC SAFETY FUNDING APPLICATION
Application Deadline: 5:00 pm, December 15, 2016**

Background

The City of Goleta ("City") has a unique relationship with Camino Real LLC ("CR-LLC") whereby CR-LLC provides annual donations to the City's Public Safety Donation Fund ("PSDF"). The contributions to the PSDF are to be used for funding Public Safety needs – Operations and Equipment purchases, Public Education and Emergency Preparedness Efforts – Community Emergency Response Training (CERT), Public Outreach and Communication – Emergency Notifications Systems and/or other community projects mutually desired and agreed upon by CR-LLC and the City.

Requisition of Funds

The City through CR-LLC and its Public Safety & Emergency Preparedness Standing Committee (Public Safety Committee) has established this funding program to assist public safety efforts in the Goleta area for the benefit of the community. This informational summary is accompanied by the funding application form which provides organizations with the ability to request funding for the purchase of public safety items/supplies/efforts.

Organizations charged directly and indirectly with providing or enhancing public safety in Goleta are encouraged to apply and request funding. The City in conjunction with CR-LLC and its Public Safety Committee will review funding requests and decide on items to receive PSDF monies. All items purchased will be logged as property of the City, while in practice the items will be in possession and for use by the requesting organization.

Please Note:

- One application per requested group of items/efforts (organizations may submit multiple applications).
- While there is no expressed maximum award amount, if an award exceeds \$30,000 it must go to the City Council for approval.
- Where applicable, the City of Goleta will make purchases pursuant to the City's purchasing procedures found in the Goleta Municipal Code § 3.05 et seq.
- Electronic MS-Word application form with the ability to include attachments.
- Funding recipients will be required to provide an acknowledgement letter stating how funding was used and benefitted the City and its residents.

The deadline for submitting a funding application is December 15, 2016 with funding decisions provided by the City no later than January 16, 2017.
