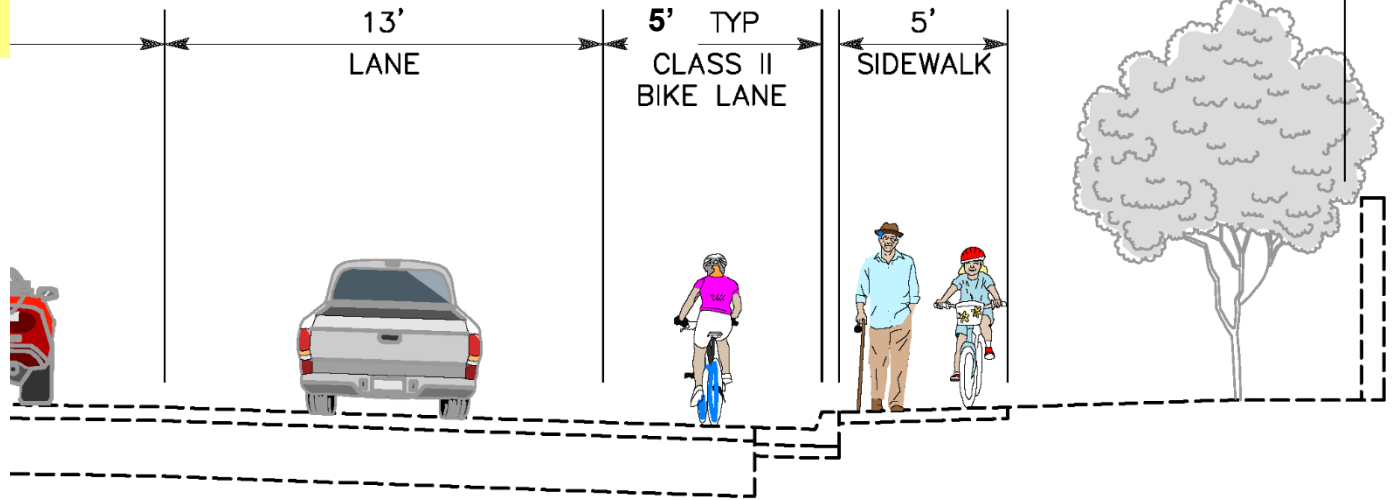
Project Location Map

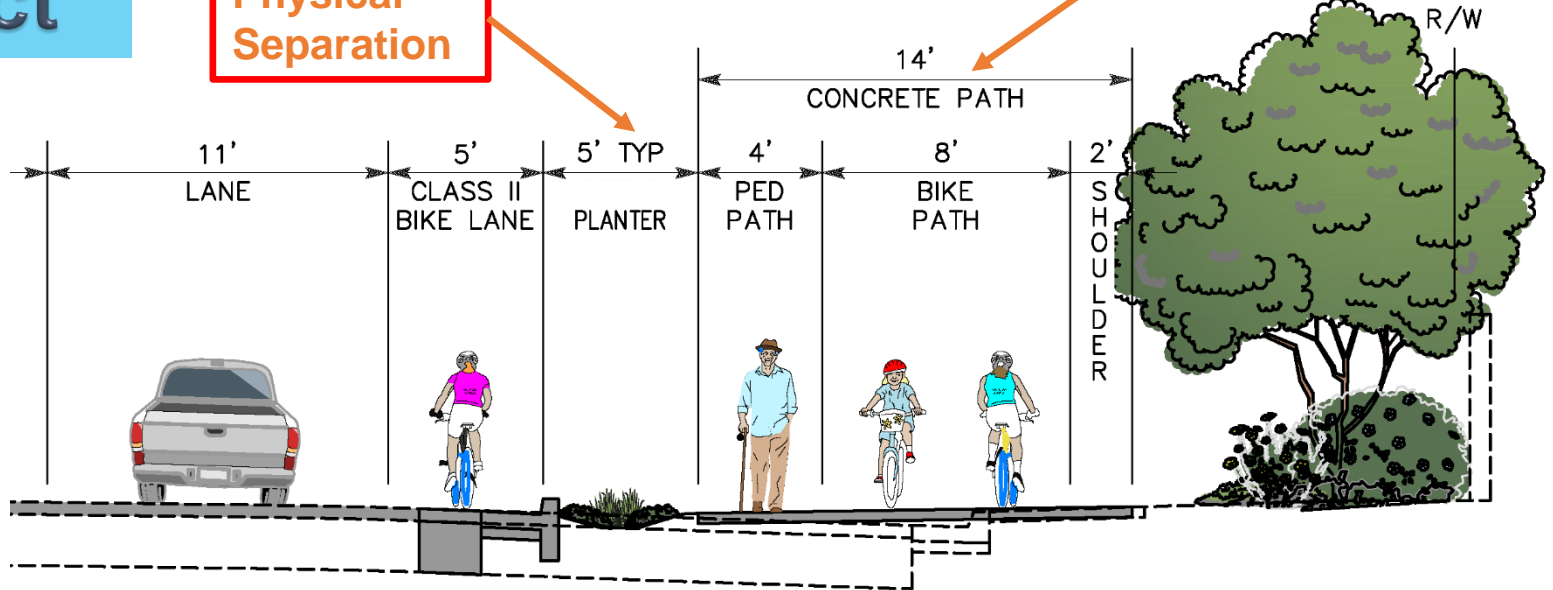

Construction Schedule

- Awarded Construction Contract March 21, 2017 to Granite Construction
- Pre-Construction Meeting scheduled for April 26, 2017
- Construction to begin in May 2017
- Complete Construction November/December 2017

Project to Be Constructed in Phases

- The Project will include a comprehensive and safe traffic control plan to ensure safety and to minimize the impact to the local residents, students, school, motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists
- Keeping School Children Safe During Construction is top priority – safety measures required during construction include:
 - **Construction Staging** to avoid impact to pathways traveled by children during months when school is in session - Construction to be phased and scheduled so that the demolition of the existing sidewalk and majority of the construction of the new pathway will take place during summer months when school is out of session
 - Provisions for providing a clear and traversable pathway for pedestrians and bicyclists at all times during construction
 - Pathways for pedestrians and bicyclists to be protected with installation of concrete barriers and traffic delineators
 - Flaggers will be provided during months when school is in session to ensure children can safely navigate any construction taking place during their commute to and from school
- The City will communicate with the public and keep residents and businesses (including Ellwood School) informed of progress of work schedule, construction stages and traffic switches, traffic control and other associated matters throughout the project construction period.
