

ORDINANCE NO. 07-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING CERTAIN TIME LIMITS WITH RESPECT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE GOLETA OLD TOWN REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT PURSUANT TO SENATE BILL 1045 AS CODIFIED IN HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 33333.6(e)(2)(C).

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Redevelopment Plan for the Goleta Old Town Redevelopment Project ("Redevelopment Plan") on June 16, 1998 by Ordinance No. 4326; and

WHEREAS, following incorporation of the City of Goleta, the City Council of Goleta ("City Council") accepted and assumed control of the Redevelopment Plan by Ordinance No. 02-19 on April 15, 2002; and

WHEREAS, Section 33333.6(e)(2)(C) of the Health and Safety Code was established by SB 1045 to provide that when an agency is required to make a payment to the Educational Revenue Augmentation Fund during fiscal year 2003-04 pursuant to Section 33681.9, the legislative body may amend the redevelopment plan to extend by one year the time limit of effectiveness of the plan and the time limit to repay indebtedness; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Goleta desires to amend the Redevelopment Plan pursuant to the authority granted in Section 33333.6(e)(2)(C).

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

The time limits on the effectiveness of the Redevelopment Plan for the Project Area, as set forth in the Redevelopment Plan, are hereby extended by one year as amended by this Ordinance.

SECTION 2.

The time limits on the collection of tax increment revenue for the Project Area, as set forth in the Redevelopment Plan, are hereby extended by one year as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 3.

Except as amended hereby, the Redevelopment Plan shall remain in full force and effect according to its terms.

SECTION 4.

All required proceedings and considerations precedent to the adoption of this Ordinance have been regularly taken in accordance with applicable law.

SECTION 5.

The City Manager shall notify the appropriate public entities of the adoption of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6.


If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrases or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrases, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof, be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 7.

The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be posted as required by law.


